## Laura,

You probably already know about these, but in the 2015 and 2016 Final QAP:

- 1. Under Positive Site Characteristics, Public Park or Playground "(private gyns will not count)" gyms is misspelled.
- 2. Under Development Characteristics, 17. "cameras monitoring roadways and parking areas and all building entrances" is going to require a camera at each doorway or at least at each end of all breezeways. Can one camera covering the first floor of each multi-story breezeway be considered at "all building entrances"? When there is one building, will a camera at the main secure entry door count as "all building entrances" or will a camera at all exterior doors be required? Can a townhouse or single family have a camera that covers multiple building front doors considered "all building entrances" or will the rear and/or side doors need cameras also? Are "roadways" the onsite driveways? Can the access/egress to the driveway be considered "monitoring roadways"?
- 3. Under For ALL New Construction Developments, 7. "at a minimum, a sink and refrigerator and either a stove/microwave" should it read stove or microwave?
