The language in the 2015-2016 QAP states; "Doctor's Office staffed full time with General Practitioner or Nurse Practitioner (specialized practices do not count); Emergency Clinics, Urgent Care Facilities, or Hospital (Facilities must be available to the general public and must not be exclusive); Walk-in Clinics (e.g., "Minute Clinics" or equivalent) that are staffed full time with a Nurse Practitioner or Physician's Assistant." In addition the QAP states that "all positive site services must be open to the general public and operational, and expected to continue to operate".

A pediatrician's office is considered a specialized practice providing medical attention to children and is therefore not eligible for points.
